Doug Cole's Coaching Tips

Technique or Tactics? There's no point in talking tactics if technique is unsound. Bowls is a target sport so let's adopt successful methods of other target sports like archery, shooting (rifle, shotgun, pistol) and darts. All require visualisation of a delivery line. Bowls has the advantage of seeing one on the green or at least a spot on it to aim our bowl at and over. Our disadvantage is that we release our bowl while moving which seriously affects our balance.

Briefly:

- 1. Stand on the mat about half side-on with feet apart, both sideways and one ahead of the other but not in line.
- 2. Stand alongside your delivery line i.e. parallel to it, not on it so you will swing your bowl above it.

Closure of Greens

Following uncertainty regarding closure of Bucks greens for a recent Saturday Pennant game, the Bowls Committee have determined protocols as follows for the closure of greens for pennant:

BTS Conditions of Play require that, except in exceptional circumstances, a decision against the start of play ,must not be made prior to two hours before the scheduled start of play.

The <u>synthetic green</u> is never closed. Even if it is under water, if the rain stops the green will drain within half an hour and will then be playable.

The Greenkeeper is the only person authorised to close the <u>grass green</u>. If he does close the grass green, he will advise the authorised greens person who is Arija Bayles. If that happens, she will advise the relevant Side Captain and put notice of the green closure on the Greens Board located just inside the front gates.

Once a game commences, any decision on whether play continue or not due to inclement weather rests with the Side Captains. If the Side Captains cannot agree, the Umpires decision shall prevail.

Drinking Water

Please bring your own water bottle to the Club for pennant and practice as the Club will no longer be providing plastic cups for water.
